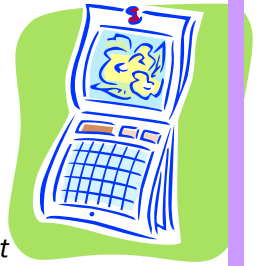
**Next Meeting - March 17<sup>th</sup>.**
